This interactive workshop will offer hands-on experience applying the concepts of the stages of change to counseling domestic violence survivors during times of crisis and as part of longer term counseling efforts. Speakers will provide background information on the behavior change model and its use for addressing other health related behaviors. They will also share results from their research with domestic violence survivors that support the use of stages of change for counseling women. Workshop participants will have an opportunity to work in small groups to share their experiences working with domestic violence survivors and create new strategies that apply stages of change concepts and counseling messages. The session will close with a brief wrap of the content covered and participants' reflections on how stages of change thinking can be integrated into services for domestic violence survivors and what research is still needed to better meet their needs.
