The Family Crisis Center (FCC), a non-profit organization, has been the primary provider of domestic violence services in Prince George's County for over 30 years. Our Family Violence Intervention Clinic (FAMVIC) program provides intensive individual and group therapy sessions to abusers, survivors and victims of domestic violence.

We are seeking an experienced Bi-lingual (Spanish/English) Domestic Violence Counselor to provide a range of clinical services including crisis intervention, intakes, assessments, treatment planning, counseling, evaluations and referrals to our client population.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct intake assessments of abusers and survivors for program entry.
- Participate in staff meetings, present cases to clinical staff and create individualized treatment plans.
- Provide crisis intervention to telephone and walk-in clients.
- Conduct client orientations, provide individual counseling and facilitate abuser intervention, victim support and anger management groups.
- Contact partners of abusers to administer assessments and offer safety planning.
- Administer quality assurance and research surveys to clients.
- Follow strict documentation & confidentiality guidelines in maintaining client records.
- Prepare & maintain statistical reports on clinical services rendered.
- Communicate with and provide follow-up to referring agencies (Courts, Parole, Probation, DSS, etc.).
- Establish & maintain a cooperative, professional relationship with participants, staff & the community.
- Provide education and outreach services to the community.
- Participate in social change efforts through agency and community committees, interagency and discipline-related councils as necessary.

REQUIREMENTS

- Bachelor's degree in human services or related field. Master's degree, preferred.
- Minimum of two years' experience working with domestic violence population.
- Experience facilitating groups.
- Knowledge and understanding of trauma and domestic violence.
- Ability and desire to engage dv abusers and comfort working one-on-one.
- Knowledge of available community resources.
- Ability to establish and maintain case records and to facilitate data collection.
- Ability to maintain professional ethics and confidentiality of client information.
- Ability to work days and evenings.
- Ability to speak fluently in both English and Spanish.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Bachelor's Degree human services, social work, psychology or related field with at least 3-5 years progressive work experience. Master's Degree Preferred.
- Abuser Intervention Certification preferred, but agency will provide training to qualified candidate.
- Candidate must have a valid driver's license and will be required to pass a background check.
