Position Description: Community Advocates for Family & Youth (CAFY) is a full social services organization working to prevent, support and educate about violence and victimization located in Prince George's County, Maryland.

CAFY offers a range of services and programs including a counseling center with a diverse professional staff to help victims (adults, children and family members) with immediate crisis counseling, support and specific treatment to assist in moving survivors and co-victims of crime on the path towards healing. In a trauma informed care environment, survivors of violence receive clinical assessments, individual counseling, family/group counseling, as well as referrals for on-going services.

CAFY is looking for a bilingual (Spanish/English) licensed Social Worker/Professional Counselor who is interested in becoming part of a non-profit organization providing psychotherapy services for persons affected by violence.

The work schedule is flexible to include some evening hours to accommodate client schedules and a maximum of six Saturdays for in-services trainings and peer collaboration.

This is a salaried employment opportunity.

- Responsibilities:**
- Provide one-on-one psychotherapy sessions to clients of CAFY who are experiencing a wide range of emotional, psychological, personal, or trauma difficulties in Spanish and English.
 - Complete thorough assessments, develop treatment plans, and provide supportive counseling, crisis intervention and therapy.
 - Provide clinical services (caseload can consist of individuals, as well as, family members on an individual, couples and family basis).
 - Work with victims of intimate partner violence, abuse or exploitation, and facilitate the identification and implementation of healthy boundaries and effective communication techniques.
 - Work with team members in an effort to maximize clients' potential for the healthiest coping responses to their challenging situation.
 - Collaborate with case managers for services outside treatment plan as needed.
 - Maintain and record timely appropriate notes, dates, and logs regarding assigned client to improve quality of services.
 - Other duties as assigned.



- Qualifications:**
- **Education:** Master's degree in social work, counseling, psychology or closely related field, with a minimum of two years of relevant clinical experience, a portion of which should be in trauma work. Must possess a current Maryland license at the independent clinical practitioner level (LGPC, LCPC, LGSW or LCSW).
 - Fluent in both English and Spanish (written & verbal).
 - Must demonstrate a commitment and ability to serve a diverse community.
 - Experience working with persons affected by crime and must be able to deliver, or be willing to learn to deliver, services using evidence-based practices.
 - Excellent communication skills and clinical judgment.
 - Detail-oriented, excellent teamwork skills and possess an open mind regarding cultures, religions and sexuality.
 - Knowledge of the social basis of behavior such as the psychology of interpersonal relationships, group processes, and organizational and systems theory.
 - Knowledge of psych diagnostic and psychotherapeutic theories and techniques such as cognitive behavior modification, solution-focused and individual or group therapy.
 - Experience utilizing therapeutic methods and counseling techniques in an effective manner.
 - Experience establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with clients, staff, guardians, family members, and representatives of other agencies and organizations.
