FAIR Girls is a direct service organization serving cis and transgender young women and girls aged 11 to 26 in the D.C. metro area and Maryland as well as thru our global programs. FAIR Girls provides care to over 100 young women survivors of human trafficking annually and offers emergency housing thru our Vida Home for young women aged 18 to 26.

FAIR Girls offers 24/7 on-call crisis intervention support and emergency case management services to any youth victim referred for services through law enforcement and other community partners. FAIR Girls' case managers specialize in providing trauma-informed and survivor-centered interventions for victims and provide a safe space for victims to feel free to share their story and begin to repair their life, thus moving from a victim to a survivor. The FAIR Girls Vida Home is the only safe emergency housing for survivors in the metro D.C. area, with 8 beds set aside for survivors in need of a place to stay as they begin their recovery.

Currently, FAIR Girls' clients are 90% American citizens, 10% foreign nationals. Over 85% of our clients are young women of girl and 10% identify as transgender. The average of entry into a life of exploitation is 14 to 16 years old.

FAIR Girls' work has been featured on the Oprah Winfrey Network (OWN), Marie Claire, Huffington Post, CNN, BBC, the New York Times, America's Most Wanted, and MSNBC.

FAIR Girls seeks a Maryland Prevention Education Coordinator to join FAIR Girls' efforts to expand a national trafficking prevention education program to empower youth to avoid and escape situations of human trafficking. There are 100,000 American youth at risk toward commercial sexual exploitation every year.

Position: Maryland Prevention Education Coordinator

Under the supervision of the Maryland Programs Manager, the will schedule, coordinate, and manage FAIR Girls' training and outreach to Prince George's County public schools, foster case homes, after school programs, and law enforcement agencies. The Maryland Prevention Education Coordinator will be responsible for FAIR Girls' training of educators and social service providers on commercial sexual exploitation of children and our school-based trafficking prevention programs specifically in Prince George's Country.

This position will be based in Prince George's County, Maryland and will be expected to participate in monthly visits to Washington, D.C. and to accommodate monthly visits from FAIR Girls staff. This position will be responsible for reporting to the FAIR Girls Maryland Program Manager and will receive bimonthly supervision from FAIR Girls' Clinical Director. The Maryland Prevention Education Coordinator will supervise a minimum of two classroom interns at any given time.

Job Duties:

Program Management (20%):

- Execute FAIR Girls' anti-trafficking prevention curriculum in Maryland, specifically Prince George's County;
- Research best practices for culturally specific anti-human trafficking prevention curriculum;
- Recruit, hire, train, and manage all prevention education fellows and staff in the Prince George's County program;
- Maintain documentation and produce reports of all presentations, educational tools, and materials;
- Maintain prevention program evaluations and deliver quarterly and annual program reports

School Based Trafficking Intervention Program Implementation (70%):

- Conduct regular outreach, scheduling, and training to DC social service provider agencies that work with youth that results in 500 teens educated about human trafficking on an annual basis
- Maintain, strengthen and develop new relationships in the Prince George's County and area public schools and foster group homes, detention facilities, and other youth programs.
- Schedule and teach FAIR Girls' anti trafficking prevention curriculum to local Prince George's County area schools, youth shelters, detention facilities, foster group homes, and youth center

Adult Trainings (10%):

- Provide backstopping to Maryland Program Manager by occasionally facilitating FAIR Girls' training curriculum for social service providers, law enforcement, teachers, and other agencies;
- Collaborate with community allies to facilitate that human trafficking prevention efforts are happening across agencies;
- Attend and actively engage in all Prince George's Country Human Trafficking Task Force meetings and training committee meetings
- Represent FAIR Girls at local and national venues;

Preferred Qualifications: Bachelors or masters degree in social work or law, experience working within the criminal justice and family court systems, experience working with survivors of trafficking or other forms of violence against women, strong work ethic, positive attitude, empathetic outlook, excellent written and verbal communication, and flexibility. Spanish speakers and survivors of gender based violence, including human trafficking, highly desired. Sense of humor and desire to truly be a part of a diverse and dedicated team of human rights advocates a must! Survivors highly encouraged to apply.

Benefits: FAIR Girls offers a generous benefit and compensation package that includes health care, four weeks paid vacation, 16 holidays including the week between Christmas Eve and New Years, flex time, and a truly dynamic and diverse work environment.
